



## Vaccination requirements for entry and how they are presented

All vet documents can be bi-lingual but must include English – No other single language document will be accepted for either vaccination documents, international health certificates, or other supporting documents where required. Where names, breed or details are listed in another language on the vaccination documents, it is acceptable to write an English translation next to the information:

Vaccination books must contain:

- Matching pet details in full (Name, breed, sex, DOB, microchip number & date)
  - Breed must contain at least 1 identifiable breed (mix breed or cross breed alone is not acceptable)
- Original Manufacturer Vaccine stickers
- Vet signature (NOT BLACK INK)
- Clinic stamp
- Clearly defined administered date DD MM YYYY

It will be assumed that ALL dates listed in documents are DD MM YYYY no matter the origin unless clearly stated as US Format by the administering vet.

- American documents can be accepted at MM DD YYYY but this must be clearly identified as the format

ALL pets must have an internationally recognised Rabies Vaccination administered between 1 and 12 months before date of entry to Saudi Arabia

- This is a government issued entry requirement for rabies vaccination to Saudi Arabia. The listed or expected expiry date of vaccination (1, 2 or 3 years) is completely irrelevant, it is based on the administration date alone
- ✓ Cats must have a valid FVRCP vaccine - this vaccine protects against Feline Viral Rhinotracheitis (feline herpes), Panleukopenia virus (feline distemper), and Calicivirus
- ✓ Dogs must have a valid DHPPi – ensuring cover for Canine parvovirus; Distemper; Canine hepatitis.

If ANY element of the above are missing from your vaccination book, you must obtain the following for the application to be accepted, and original to travel with your pet:

If you don't have a vaccination book or card, the ministry will accept an original certificate as follows:

- Vet issued Signed & stamped vaccination certificate containing the pets' full details and the vaccination details. It must have the Dr's name, clinic name and address and licence number
- We can provide a template on request
