

Please note below the entry requirements for cats/dogs to Thailand, which are pretty straight forward and as follows;

- o They should be microchipped
- o They should be having up-to-date rabies and annual feline/canine vaccinations - the DHLPPi/Tri-Cat - with the rabies vaccination being at least 30 days old at the time of travel, if it is a primary (first) or a booster to a lapsed vaccine.
- o Additionally, there is also a requirement for the Export Health Certificate issued by the UAE Ministry of Climate Change & Environment (MOCCAE) and this must be gained **within 10 days** of travel.
- o On Thailand's side, there is an **import permit** required. We can connect you to an agent for this if required, in due course.

Meanwhile, in case you don't already know, for your cat/dog's flight, you may have more options if you're travelling around the same time as them and depending on the airline that you are travelling with. One is to take them with you in cabin as hand luggage (i.e. as part of your flight ticket); the second is as accompanied/excess baggage in the cargo hold (again, as part of your flight ticket) and lastly is as manifested cargo.
